

GPA Submission Opt-Out Waiver Form

Assembly Bill 2160 was signed into law in September 2014 mandating that all public schools electronically submit grade point averages (GPAs) for grade twelve students to the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC). The bill also requires the school district to notify parents in writing of opt-out requirements by October 15, 2015 for current grade twelve students. By completing the form below, you realize that you are requesting that your son/daughter's GPA not be submitted in accordance with AB 2160.
